Credibility

An independent, multi-stakeholder organisation monitors our brands' activities and publicly reports on them.



Advanced work in factories:

- Complaints helplines Our brands work with their suppliers to resolve any (anonymous) worker complaints.
- J Factory audits Factories are audited to find out how well they comply with Fair Wear labour standards and later, to see how they've made changes. To ensure workers can speak freely, we also conduct offsite interviews.
- Training We train workers and management on their rights. We cover everything from living wages to reasonable working hours.



Play by the rules

Fair Wear companies demonstrate how they respect human rights under international guidelines and national laws and regulations. They work to improve the conditions in their supply chains.



Transparency

Our brands are remarkably open about the conditions and complaints received in the factories that make their garments. That way, everyone can hold them accountable.
